Dear Parents,

November School Circular (Form 4)

Please take note to the following issues.

1. First Term Examination

- First Term Examination of Form Four to Form Six will be held from 2th November (Monday) to 13th November (Friday)
- The examination is scheduled to conduct in the morning (Students attending written examination should come to school by 7:50am). Parents are advised to take note of the dates and time of the examination. Enclosed herewith is the first term examination timetable for your kind reference. Please urge your children to prepare for the examination and try their best in the revision.

(Should there be any special circumstances occurred during the examination, for example, class suspension announced by the Education Bureau, the examination affected on that date will be cancelled and the make-up examination arrangement will be announced later. The remaining examination will not be affected.)

- Students who fail to attend the examination due to sickness are required to submit a Sick Leave Certificate issued by a doctor and a parent's letter, otherwise, zero marks will be given to the examination papers involved and will be regarded as truancy.)
- Students are not allowed to bring a mobile phone or a smart watch with them during the examination (please refer to the Conduct of Examination in the Student Handbook). Students found with these items will be treated as "attempting to cheat".
- The written exam for PE will be held during the Class Teacher Period on 30/10. Students are informed of the scope of examination by their subject teacher.

2. Influenza Vaccination

Influenza is very active in Autumn and Winter. Diseases can spread easily in the crowd. Children are particularly vulnerable to infection by 40% higher than adults. The risk of infection will increase when they study in air-conditioned classrooms for prolonged period in school.

In order to avoid students from contracting influenza, vaccination is recommended. Students are sponsored by our alumni to receive quadrivalent influenza at a cheaper cost of HK\$150.00. Participating students who feel ill will not be given vaccination, and the fee will be refunded after. The details of the vaccination are as follows.

Date : 27th November (Friday)

Venue : School Hall

Time : During lessons (schedule for vaccine injection will be announced later)

3. Bill payments for 1st stage
