#### **(1) Bill payments for 1<sup>st</sup> stage**

### (4) Student Accident Insurance

In order to provide a more comprehensive care for students' safety and needs, school will offer "Group Personal Accident Insurance" free of charge for students in this academic year. Details of the insurance coverage are set out below for your attention.

Type of Insurance: Group Personal Accident Insurance

Period of Insurance: 2024 to 2025 academic year (1 / 9/ 2024 - 31 / 8/ 2025)

Coverage:

1. Against Accidental Death or Injury incurred during the normal School Year.
2. Coverage commences everyday while the Insured Person leaves home directly to school during each normal school day and lasts when the Insured Person leaves the school directly to home and ceases until he/she returns home or 2 hours after schooling, whichever first occurs.
3. Coverage also commences when the Insured Person leaves home directly to the place of gathering point to attend any designated activity which is arranged / organised / endorsed by the Insured, and lasts until the Insured Person leaves the place of designated activity directly to home and ceases until he / she returns home or 2 hours after he/she leaves the place of designated activity, whichever first occurs.
