School Circular for June (F.5)

Please take note of the following issues.

1. Final Examination

1. Final Examination for Form Five will be held from 4th June (Friday) to 18th June (Friday). 21st June and 22nd June will be the reserve examination day.
2. The examination is scheduled to conduct in the morning (Students attending written examination should come to school by 7:50am). Parents are advised to take note of the dates and time of the examination. Enclosed herewith is the final examination timetable for your kind reference. Please urge your children to prepare for the examination and try their best in the revision. (Should there be any special circumstances occurred during the examination, for example, class suspension announced by the Education Bureau, the examination affected on that date will be cancelled and the make-up examination arrangement will be announced later. The remaining examination will not be affected.)
3. Students who fail to attend the examination due to sickness are required to submit a Sick Leave Certificate issued by a doctor and a parent's letter, otherwise, zero marks will be given to the examination papers involved and will be regarded as truancy.
4. If students have any symptoms of cold, please let the children stay at home for rest and should consult a doctor as soon as possible.
5. Students are not allowed to bring a mobile phone or a smart watch with them during the examination (please refer to the Conduct of Examination in the Student Handbook). Students found with these items will be treated as "attempting to cheat".

2. Mark Checking Day, Post-Exam Activities Day

3. Checking of provisional report cards

Provisional report cards will be delivered at 9:00 a.m. on 30th June (Wednesday). Students are advised to return to school on schedule and check the result of each subject. Should there be any mistakes, please contact the subject teacher on or before 9:45 a.m. on the same day. Late request will not be accepted.

4. Diversified Learning Day

In order to enrich students' learning experiences, Diversified Learning Day will be held on 30th June (Friday afternoon), which is organised by the Extracurricular activities Team. For details, please refer to the notice which will be issued by the Other Learning Experience Team soon.

5. The Swimming Gala

The Swimming Gala to be held on July 2 (Friday) will be cancelled.

6. Arrangement for F.6 students to withdraw subjects (2021-2022)

(a) Objectives:

In order to cater for F.6 students who have learning difficulties, the school allows students to drop DSE elective subjects so that they can concentrate on the study to achieve desirable results in public examinations.

(b) Application

There are two stages for F.6 students to apply for subject withdrawal. **The first stage** starts from **24th June to 5th July**. **The second stage** starts from **18th August to 3rd September**. Each student is allowed to drop one elective subject ONLY. Should any students who wish to drop more than one subject, they are required to apply by writing to the school. (When applying for withdrawal of any electives, please note the requirement of the tertiary institute. You may refer to the attachment for reference.)

(I) First Stage (24th June – 5th July)

- Students who wish to drop elective subjects can take an Application Form for subject withdrawal at the School office during the period between **24th June and 5th July** and return the form to the School office **on or before 5th July**. Late application will not be accepted.
- A name list of accepted students will be posted on the notice board of the Academic affairs outside the school hall on 12th July. The listed students are required to go to the library/ designated places for self-study or tutorials starting from the specified date (to be confirmed later).
- Accepted students are not required to attend the tutorial class of that subject during the summer vacation.

(II) Second Stage (18th August – 3rd September)

- The application procedure is the same as the first stage. Students who wish to drop an elective subject can take an Application Form for subject withdrawal at the School office during the period between **18th August and 3rd September** and return the form to the School office **on or before 3rd September**. Late application will not be accepted.
- The approved name list will be announced in early September. Students are required to go to the library/ designated places for self-study or tutorials after the specified date.

7. Daily marks calculation for Chinese and English languages in this academic year

Owing the impacts of the pandemic, some of the daily assignment of language subjects may be affected. Based on the daily assignment and homework, Chinese and English language panels will calculate the daily marks as follows:

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*Students need to participate in English activities or English corner activities at least 10 times
