**1. Post-exam activities**

(c) **Notes to students**

- Daily class timetable will be different for students depending on the subjects they choose, therefore, students are required to attend the designated classes on time according to the subjects they study.

- As some bridging course will be held in special rooms (such as Geography Room, Computer Room), students are required to go to the designated room for lessons. If the last session of the class takes place in the special room, students can take all their own belongings there. Classes will be dismissed in that designated classroom once after the school bell rings.

Please note that the Pre-S4 English bridging programme originally scheduled on 28-30/8 will be carried out during lesson periods in the new school year.
