**School Circular for December (F.4 – F.5)**

Please take note of the following issues.

**1. The Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception**

The Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated on 5<sup>th</sup> December (Friday). All students are required to wear winter school uniforms. Catholic students, students from the Catechism Class and Sodalities should arrive at school by 8:30 a.m. to attend the Mass in the school hall. Other students should arrive at school by 9:00 a.m. to attend the religious ceremony at the playground. After the ceremony, various activities will be arranged for students to participate in until 11:30 a.m. Students are free to return home and there will have no class in the afternoon.

**2. The Day following the Polling Day**

8<sup>th</sup> December (Monday) will be the day following the polling day, students have no classes on that day.

**4. Swimming Gala**

The 58<sup>th</sup> Swimming Gala will be held on 18<sup>th</sup> December (Thursday) at the Victoria Park Swimming Pool in

Causeway Bay. Students must wear neat school uniforms and arrive at the venue before 8:30 am. Students who will participate in the swimming competition must wear swimming trunks and swimming caps. (Please refer to the Chinese version for Map and instruction to the swimming pool). Mr. Cheng Pui Hong, our graduate in 2024, will be our guest to present the prizes and deliver speech to us. The Swimming Gala will end at about 12:30pm, students can go home on their own and there will be no classes in the afternoon.

Those who will participate in the Swimming Gala must fill in the “Parents’ Consent Form” to indicate your son is in good health and agrees to participate in the event, otherwise he will not be allowed to participate in the events.

## 5. Christmas Celebration and Christmas Holidays

Christmas Celebration will be held on 19<sup>th</sup> December (Friday). All students are required to return to school and participate in the “Christmas Party” before 8:25am. Programmes include religious ceremony and class-based activities. All the programmes will end at about 11:30 a.m. Students are free to return home and there will be no class in the afternoon. Students should bring along their students cards and can wear casual clothes in decent manner to school.

Christmas and New Year Holidays start from 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2025 (Monday) to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026 (Thursday). School resumes classes on 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2026 (Tuesday) (Day 6).
