School Circular for January (F.4)

Please take note of the following issues.

(1) The 71st Athletic Meet (Heat)

Our 71st Athletic Meet (Heat) is scheduled for 5th January (Monday) from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Wan Chai Sports Ground. Students are required to wear school uniform and arrive at the venue by 8:00 a.m. Participants are required to wear school's P.E. uniform or class shirt. (Please refer to the map attached. Students are reminded to use footbridge when getting to the venue.)

Participants who fail to return the Parent's Approval Slip are not allowed to take part in the Athletic Meet (Heat).

(2) Diversified Learning Day

To broaden students' learning horizons and enable them to explore their potential and interests, the Extra-curricular Activities Committee organizes the 'Life-Wide Learning Day' annually.

This academic year, the Life-Wide Learning Day is scheduled for Friday, January 9, 2026, after the lunch break. In the morning, the school will follow the normal class timetable (from Morning Assembly to the 5th period).

To enhance students' knowledge of Chinese culture and strengthen their sense of national identity, the Committee has arranged a visit to the Hong Kong Palace Museum. The activity is free of charge. Students will visit Thematic Galleries 1 to 7 to learn about our country's history, culture, and achievements. Additionally, they will have free access to Special Gallery 8, featuring treasures from the Victoria and Albert Museum in England. To maximize learning, the Chinese Language and Chinese History Departments have designed specific tasks for students to complete during the visit.

The visit is scheduled from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Students must report to their classrooms on or before 1:15 p.m. before taking a coach to the West Kowloon Cultural District. After the activity, teachers will lead the students to Kowloon Station for dismissal. Students wishing to stay behind at the museum must submit a parent letter to their Class Teacher.

Please note the following:

1. The Life-wide Learning Day is a regular activity of the school, and all students must participate.
2. If students need to take leave (sick leave or personal leave), they must follow the established procedures to apply for leave from the school, otherwise, it will be considered as truancy.

(3) The Feast Day of St. John Bosco and Thanksgiving Day

The Feast Day of St. John Bosco and Thanksgiving Day will be held on 23rd January (Friday). Students are required to arrive at school before 9:00am and then attend the religious ceremony and Thanksgiving ceremony at the covered playground. The activity is expected to finish at 11:00 am. Students can leave school and return home. There will be no class in the afternoon. (All students are required to wear winter school uniforms on this school day.)

Students who participate in Thanksgiving ceremony or performance show must follow the instructions assigned by the teachers and attend the rehearsal or fulfill the duty on time.

(4) Lunar New Year Holidays

Lunar New Year Holidays start from 16th February (Monday) to 24th February (Tuesday). School resumes classes on 25th February (Wednesday (Day 5)).
